2SLGBTQ+ POVERTY IN CANADA: IMPROVING LIVELIHOOD AND SOCIAL WELLBEING

Call for Peer Researchers

We are currently seeking Peer Researchers to:

- Coordinate individual and group interviews, including the payment of participant honoraria, consent and data collection;
- Conduct 60-minute individual interviews with 2SLGBTQ+ people with a history of or currently living in poverty;
- Co-facilitate 90-minute interview groups with between 10 – 12 2SLGBTQ+ people with a history of or currently living in poverty;
- Create notes for each individual and group interview;
- Audio-record interviews and submit files to Peer Researcher Coordinators;
- Check accuracy of transcripts;
- Be in regular communication with Peer Researcher Coordinators.

Peer Researcher assets include:

- Identify as 2SLGBTQ+ or have a demonstrated relationship, connection with, and/or knowledge of 2SLGBTQ+ communities;
- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Reside in Canada;
- Have previous experience and/or currently experiencing poverty;
- Have research experience in conducting individual interviews and/or facilitating focus groups;
- Understand and fluently speak English and/or French;
- Be available to conduct in-person, virtual, and telephone interviews and in-person and virtual focus groups from October 2023 to March 2024.

**Training will be provided to all Peer Researchers.
If required, related travel expenses will be covered.**
